The ASFP serves and represents the needs of its members and the wider passive fire protection industry, promoting continuous improvement in all aspects of passive fire protection and by working with Government and international standard setting bodies both directly, and via other sector group associations, the ASFP endeavours to increase the quality of installed fire protection within all forms of construction, leading regulatory and behavioural change as an independent authority whilst improving competence and quality through training.		
	Phil Brownhill was appointed as Head of Training to establish the ASFP's (Association for Specialist Fire Protection) new training programme, with a view to improving levels of competency throughout the passive fire protection sector of the construction industry, from design to installation and ongoing maintenance. Phil has over 30 years of experience in the passive fire protection industry, having started his career with Promat in 1989 and worked for a range of manufacturers including Cafco and Isolatek International. He also worked with Building Research Establishment in the development of its Installer certification scheme. Phil has been involved in a range of ASFP, British Standards Institute and CEPE committees, the European Council for the paint Industry dealing with reactive fire protection coatings and was Chairman of the ASFP TG2 task group responsible for non-reactive fire protection to steel sector.
