Agenda

The meeting is conducted in two parts, led by two guest speakers.

Part 1: Client H&S Adviser

Paul Whitehead of Quadriga Health & Safety Ltd. share his experience as a clientside health and safety adviser. Paul talks about the H&S Forms 1 to 8.

Part 2: PD Role within CDM 2015

Mark Webster of MPW R&R provides an overview of the review of CDM 2025 PD role. Mark is a charted engineer. Currently focusing on structural safety, including provide consultancy and expert witness service. He led the review of CDM 1994, 2007 and now 2015 PD role.

MPW R&R prepared the report, <u>Implementation of the Principal Designer Role within CDM 2015 (RR 1198)</u> and the <u>Technical Annex</u> that contain detailed analyses of the information obtained from the survey and stakeholder interviews. Mark is scheduled to join the next DIOHAS meeting on 11th September 2023 where the agenda is to discuss the report and technical annex.

When HSE tender the report before Christmas 2020, the intension was to review how the role of PD was implemented, not to change the role. At that time, the Building Safety Act PD role has not emerged. HSE set up five objectives for the review:

- What organisations and individuals make up the PD community which includes PD and PD adviser?
- 2. What activities the PD community carry out as part of the role?
- 3. How the PD role influence the H&S management in the five industry sectors prescribed by HSE?
- 4. To what extend the PD role operating in comparison to the functions set out in CDM 2015? In other words, how is it complying with the Regulation?
- 5. What behaviour impact positively & negatively on the effectiveness of PD?

The review time scale was three months in 2021. The review team was not allowed to use the F10 database to get contact names, who are most relevant stake holders. This is due to the General Data Protection Regulation (GGPR) – HSE didn't seek consent in the F10 form for information to be used research purpose. The F10 database was accessible for the CDM 2007 review.

As a result, the review team resort to a combination of social media, reach out to institution and associations, HSE press releases, etc. The review team eventually received 849 responses in total. The survey asked questions related to:

- General information about the organisation / individual.
- Their role on recent projects and how regulatory roles was discharged.
- How the other four CDM 2015 duty holders view the PD.
